- Mother Teresa was an inspiration to countless millions for her lifelong devotion to the needlest and most vulnerable of the world.
 - The selflessness and sacrifice with which she lived her own life made her an international symbol of charitable work.
- The love and compassion she showed the destitute of all faiths won her a Nobel Peace Prize in 1979. She donated it entirely to the poor.
 - Mother Teresa found her inspiration in Catholic teachings.
- Mother Teresa was born with the name Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu. She was born in Skopje, Macedonia on August 26, 1910.
 - Her family was of Albanian descent.
- At the age of twelve, she knew she had to be a missionary to spread the love of Christ.
- At the age of 18, she left her home in Skopje and joined an Irish community of nuns with missions in India called the Sisters of Loreto.
- She won widespread affection and admiration in her adopted home of Calcutta, India by respecting local customs and beliefs, and always placing our common humanity above religious divisions.
 - By 2013, the charitable organization she had set up called the Missionaries of Charity, had spread to 700 missions in 130 countries. They provided soup kitchens, centers for family assistance, orphanages, schools, hospitals and homes for people with diseases such as leprosy, AIDS and tuberculosis.
 - In 2016, Mother Teresa was canonized by the Roman Catholic Church as Saint Teresa.
